



PROFESSOR (DR.) SAROJ MANDAL



Professor (Dr.) Saroj Mandal, MBBS, MD (Med), DM (Cardio), FRCP (Edinburgh), FRCP (Glasgow), FACC (USA), FSCAI (USA), is an eminent Interventional Cardiologist, educator, and healthcare leader from Kolkata.

2. Born on 15th September, 1967, Professor (Dr.) Mandal received his MBBS degree from the University of Calcutta in 1993, followed by post-graduation in Paediatrics in 1998 and Medicine in 2001. He pursued DM (Cardiology) from IPGMER and SSKM Hospital. His professional career began as Registrar in Medicine at CMC Vellore and later Ramkrishna Seva Mission Pratishthan & VIMS, Kolkata. He joined IPGMER & SSKM Hospital as Clinical Tutor in 2002. He holds the position of senior Interventional Cardiologist at Woodland Multispecialty Hospital. As Professor & Unit Head of Cardiology at IPGMER & SSKM Hospital with an illustrious career spanning 35 years, he has excelled in Intervention Cardiology for over 25 years, illuminating the medical landscape of Eastern India.

3. Professor (Dr.) Mandal is a visionary healthcare leader, he founded Krishnaya Institute Cardiac & Fetal Sciences (KICFS) in Kolkata in 2022, offering subsidised cardiac care accessible and affordable to thousands. He donates his remuneration to the hospital's welfare trust, ensuring every penny serves the underserved. His philanthropy extends to Nepalgunj Pailan Kolkata, where he's establishing a community-based cardiovascular unit, this initiative, built on his decade-long service through hundreds of free medical camps, is a model for public health innovation. He spearheaded the Tele Cardiology STEMI Programme in West Bengal, delivering timely cardiac interventions to thousands of rural hearts. He contributed to drafting Hypertension and Type II Diabetes Protocols for the Government of West Bengal and Emergency Cardiology Management Guidelines.

Professor (Dr.) Mandal has served over 600,000 patients in OPD over 35 years, and independently performed and supervised 50,000 coronary angiograms, 15,000 angioplasties, 15,000 pacemaker device implantations and 5000 valve micro-surgery procedures. He holds the distinction of having performed a significant number of pacemaker device implantations globally and a record of 22 pacemaker device implantations in a single day. Most part this service was dedicated to undeserved unprivileged people of the country. He has over 100 publications, 15 chapters contribution in books and editorial contributions in 6 books. As a professor-teacher, he has been mentoring and educating generations of MBBS, MD, and DM students, serving as an examiner and thesis guide for MD (Medicine), DM/DNB Cardiology courses and this has played a pivotal role in shaping the careers of future leaders in Medicine & Cardiology over the decades.

Professor (Dr.) Mandal has been conferred numerous awards, honorary diplomas and fellowships by esteemed medical societies in India and abroad, including: Fellowship of Indian College of Physicians-FICP in 2013, European Society of Cardiology-FESC in 2013, Society for Coronary Angiography & Intervention-FSCAI, USA in 2014, Asian Pacific Society of Interventional Cardiology-FAPSIC in 2015, American College of Cardiology-FACC in 2015, Cardiology Society of India-FCSI in 2017, Royal College of Physicians of Glasgow-FRCP in 2018, Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh-FRCP in 2022. His notable awards include Decade's Best Doctor from Krishnanagar West Bengal, Mother Teresa International Award from Dubai-UAE (2025), and Leading Interventional Cardiologist & Philanthropist by Time Group (twice).
